



Our Job Center is fully wheelchair accessible and offers the following Assistive Technology for Job Seekers with disability or language barriers:

Magnifier for Windows – A screen magnifier program for visually impaired job seekers to use with Windows 7. Allows for several options including top bar magnification, full-screen panning up to 16x and lens magnification.

NVDA Screen Reader – NonVisual Desktop Access (NVDA) is a free, open source, portable screen reader for Microsoft Windows. NVDA uses eSpeak as its integrated speech synthesizer, and also supports SAPI synthesizers. Besides general Windows functionality, NVDA works with software such as Microsoft Office, WordPad, Notepad, Internet Explorer, Google Chrome, and Mozilla Firefox. It supports the basic functions of Outlook Express, Microsoft Word, Microsoft PowerPoint and Microsoft Excel.

IntelliKeys USB Keyboard – Intellikeys is an adaptive keyboard. Instead of pressing keys on a standard keyboard, users touch a printed overlay that has been placed over a touch-sensitive panel. Areas on the printed overlay correspond to keys on a standard keyboard and mouse buttons. By using these overlays a job seeker can type, enter numbers, navigate on-screen displays, and execute menu commands. There are 7 standard overlays that come with the IntelliKeys keyboard.

Closed-circuit Television Magnifier - Is available to enlarge text and images on printed material from 3-30x normal text size and project onto a monitor for ease of viewing. Our CCTV will project both color and black and white documents.

TTY – A text telephone is available for use by deaf, hard of hearing, or speech impaired job seekers.

Trackball Mouse – Our dedicated computer station is equipped with a trackball mouse for ease of use.

Language Line – Language Line translation service available in order to communicate with job seekers whose primary language is not English. Language Line has the ability to translate up to 200 languages.
